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Oncology Outcomes Update

Colorectal Cancer Dashboard Progress

Due to the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, colorectal cancer screening, prevention and care have suffered. To address this issue, Oncology Outcomes has begun a project which intends to develop an online dashboard which displays real-time colorectal cancer screening, diagnostic and surgical data. This dashboard will allow for previous colorectal cancer data to be accessed, as well as estimates for the backlog of screening, diagnostic and surgical data across Alberta.

To date, a functional interface, which can present and visualize colorectal cancer data has been constructed. This interface can be used to view current and historical statistics pertaining to colorectal cancer diagnoses, mortality, colonoscopy procedures, FIT tests, and surgical procedures. For the next stages of the project, colorectal cancer data will need to be obtained, analyzed, and used to populate the dashboard. When completed, this dashboard will allow for researchers, healthcare professionals, and members of the public to become better informed about colorectal cancer statistics, informing future research and healthcare decisions.
