Estimates of the current and future burden of cancer attributable to lack of physical activity in Canada

STUDY PURPOSE

To estimate the number of incident cancer cases in Canada due to inadequate physical activity



To estimate the number of preventable cancer cases using evidence-based interventions.

CONCLUSIONS & FUTURE IMPACT

11,553 cancer cases (6.2%) attributable to inadequate recreational physical activity





50% reduction in inadequate physical activity



Future studies could examine more variables excluded from this study



Patient-Reported Symptom Burden and Supportive Care Needs of Patients With Stage II-III Colorectal Cancer During and After Adjuvant Systemic Treatment: A Real-World Evidence Study

STUDY PURPOSE

Describe the symptom burden and supportive care needs of patients with colorectal cancer (CRC) during and after adjuvant treatment.



Determine what clinical and demographic characteristics are associated with changes to symptom burden during and after adjuvant treatment.

CONCLUSIONS & FUTURE IMPACT

Future research using Patientreported outcomes (PROs) data should examine longitudinal changes in all tumor types. PROs should be expanded to include measures for financial hardship or toxicity.
